## Regeneration Minister

### Banora Point, Far North Coast NSW

Banora Point Uniting Church is a mid-sized Congregation seeking to appoint a Minister to lead and guide it on a pathway of Congregation Regeneration. This position is the prime ministry position serving the Congregation.

Key responsibilities include:

- Facilitating and guiding a process of prayer and discernment for God's call into new forms of life and mission, with a focus on reaching those beyond the church.
- Preaching and teaching the living Word of Jesus Christ as revealed in scripture and sacrament, which is central to discipleship, evangelism and understanding God's mission to redeem the whole of creation.
- Helping to create and lead engaging worship that meets the spiritual and discipleship needs of various ages, backgrounds and religious sensibilities – maybe in different kinds of worship services.
- Leading the Church Council as it takes responsibility for overseeing the development of the regeneration project.

This would be particularly suitable for a minister with relevant tertiary qualifications, a demonstrated capacity to work across generations in worship, discipleship and outreach, and experience in Congregation regeneration, visioning, mission planning, building community partnerships, communication, building effective teams, and reconciling diverse opinions.
